Mayor Traver opened the public hearing for the 2010 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) that is being considered.

This is the second public hearing held for the proposed application for the replacement of water lines in the village.

Mayor Traver asked Jim Thatcher about the income surveys needed for the application. Mr. Thatcher said that four (4) out of the five (5) areas should qualify. It is important to get close to a 95% response rate on the surveys.

The surveys used for last year's application are still good. Mayor Traver told Mr. Thatcher if there are some residences that they need information from to contact the Clerk's office and maybe they may be able to get the information needed.

Mr. Thatcher told the board that he will be meeting with Vision Engineering to review the line distribution map they had prepared last year.

Mr. Thatcher told the board that the majority of the work will be done by the Village DPW.
