

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS
OF THE VILLAGE OF FORT EDWARD NUISANCE PROPERTIES LOCAL LAW
CONTAINED IN CHAPTER 62 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF FORT
EDWARD**

Local Law No. 1 of 2012

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward, as follows:

Section 1. Short Title and Applicability.

This Local Law shall apply to certain provisions of the Nuisance Properties Local Law of the Village of Fort Edward contained in Chapter 62 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward.

Section 2. Declaration of Policy.

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward has reviewed the provisions contained in the Nuisance Properties Local Law of the Village of Fort Edward contained in Chapter 62 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward. The Board of Trustees believes that certain amendments to the provisions contained in said Chapter 62 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward are reasonable and necessary. The recommended amendments shall therefore be enacted and authorized pursuant to the provisions of this Local Law.

Section 3. Amendments.

A. Section 62-2(B)(1) of Chapter 62 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward shall be amended to include the following new subsections:

- “(s) Section 155.25 of the Penal Law -- petit larceny.”
- “(t) Section 240.26 of the Penal Law -- harassment in the second degree.”
- “(u) Section 260.10 of the Penal Law -- endangering the welfare of a child.”
- “(v) Article 145 of the Penal Law -- criminal mischief and related offenses.”
- “(w) Article 120 of the Penal Law -- assault and related offenses.”
- “(x) Article 130 of the Penal Law -- sex offenses.”

B. Section 62-2(B)(2) of Chapter 62 of the Code of the Village of Fort Edward shall be amended to include the following new subsection:

- “(u) Chapter 23 of the Village Code -- Social Host.”

Section 4. Authority.

This Local Law is hereby adopted pursuant to the provisions of Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Section 5. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

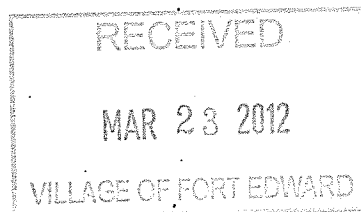
