VILLAGE OF FORT EDWARD COUNTY OF WASHINGTON, STATE OF NEW YORK LOCAL LAW No. 2 of 2009

A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF FORT EDWARD VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC LAW

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Authority.

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Section 1640 of the NYS Vehicle and Traffic Law, the Code of the Village of Fort Edward, and the NYS Municipal Home Rule Law, and the NYS Village Law.

It is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward to amend the Local Law regulating vehicles and traffic in the Village. The amendments concern the placement of stop signs which will improve the flow of traffic throughout the village. Additionally, the Local Law amends the parking regulations by increasing certain no parking areas and explicitly prohibits vehicles from being parked on the side of the highway facing traffic.

Section 2. Amendments to Language of Article VI Subsection 33

The Village hereby repeals certain Stop Intersections in the Schedule of Stop Intersections in Article VI, Subsection 33, Schedule VII, Stop Intersections. The following Stop Sign Locations are repealed in their entirety:

Section 3. Amendments to Language of Article VI Subsection 33A

The Village hereby repeals certain Stop Intersections in the Schedule of Stop Intersections in Article VI, Subsection 33A, Schedule VII, Stop Intersections. The following Stop Sign Locations are repealed in their entirety:

MCCREA STREET & VALLEY STREET
MCCREA STREET & UNDERWOOD STREET
EAST STREET & ROGER STREET
EAST STREET & WING STREET
NOTRE DAME STREET & STATE STREET
LOCK STREET & EAST STREET
NOTRE DAME STREET & BALDWIN AVENUE
SEMINARY STREET & VALLEY STREET

Section 4. Amendments to Language of Article VI Subsection 33b

A. The Village hereby repeals certain Stop Intersections in the Schedule of Stop Intersections in Article VI, Subsection 33B, Schedule VIIA, Stop Signs. The following stop sign locations are repealed in their entirety:

EAST STREET & ROGER STREET

B. The Village hereby amends certain Stop Signs location in the Schedule of Stop Sign locates in Article VI, Subsection 33B, Schedule VIIA, Stop Signs. The following additional stop signs are hereby designated on the following streets¹:

TAYLOR STREET & LOCK STREET NOTRE DAME STREET & CANAL STREET **CULVER STREET & WING STREET** TAYLOR STREET & LINCOLN AVENUE MCCREA STREET & VALLEY STREET MCCREA STREET & UNDERWOOD STREET EAST STREET & ROGERS STREET EAST STREET & WING STREET EAST STREET & SPRUCE STREET EAST STREET & LOCK STREET BALDWIN AVENUE & NOTRE DAME STREET SEMINARY STREET & VALLEY STREET SEMINARY STREET & OAK STREET DRIFTING RIDGE ROAD & TORI TRACE FRANK STREET & KING STREET MECHANIC STREET & MARION STREET MECHANIC STREET & PICKETT STREET MARION STREET & MECHANIC STREET

¹Pursuant to this subsection the stop sign shall be placed on the second street listed for the intersection, thereby directing traffic to stop on that street.

Section 5. Amendments to Language of Article VI Subsection 36

The Village hereby amends certain parking prohibitions located in the Schedule of Parking Prohibited at All Times in Article VI, Subsection 36, Schedule X. No person shall park a vehicle at any time 15 feet of any intersection and upon any of the following additionally described streets or parts of streets:

Section 6. Adoption of Subsection 15.1.

The Village hereby adopts a new Subsection 15.1 as follows:

SUBSECTION #15.1 – METHODS OF PARKING STOPPING AND STANDING

In all cases, unless angle parking is authorized by official signs of markings, vehicles shall be parked, stopped, or standing with the right-hand wheels parallel to and not more than 12 inches from the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, except on a one-way roadway where a parked vehicle must be parked parallel to the curb or edge of the roadway in the direction of authorized movement, with its right-hand wheels within 12 inches of the right-hand curb or edge of the roadway, or its left-hand wheels within 12 inches of the left-hand curb or edge of the roadway. In all angle parking areas, vehicles shall head toward the curbline.

Section 7. Repealer.

Any and all local laws or ordinances or parts of local laws or ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local Law are hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 8. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the

remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 9. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
