**PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2022-2023 TENTATIVE BUDGET**

A public hearing was held to discuss the tentative 2022-2023 budget. Mayor Traver went through the appropriations and revenues for both the Water Fund and General Fund. There was a slight decrease in revenues and a slight increase in expenditures, but the impact was offset by the pilot program ending for Irving Tissue. He highlighted some of the changes that we have done this year. With things starting to open, hopefully things will go back to normal, and our revenues will increase this year. Mayor Traver thanked everyone involved in the budget process and was happy that the Village was able to keep the tax rate very reasonable. The tax rate will decrease by 3.64% which lowers the tax rate by \$.54 per thousand to \$14.92.
