
**PUBLIC HEARING ON THE 2017-2018 TENTATIVE BUDGET**

A public hearing was held to discuss the tentative 2017-2018 budget. Mayor Traver went through the appropriations and revenues for both the Water Fund and General Fund. The proposed budget includes money to offset the loss of revenue that is coming next year due to the decrease in assessment related to the GE Dewatering facility that is currently owned by WCC, LLC. In addition the village has been preparing for this time by setting aside money each budget year. These fund will also be used, incrementally, to offset the loss of revenue. Trustee Williams said that between the years of 2013-2016, there was little to no growth in the in the budget and the village is looking at a significant decrease in revenues next year. A brief conversation about the budget was held.

There being no public comments and no further business, a motion to schedule a meeting for the adoption of the 2017-2018 village budget, and any other business that comes before the board, on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 5:30, was made by **Trustee Carpenter**, seconded by **Trustee DeVoe**. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion to close the public hearing at 6:45 was made by **Trustee Carpenter**, seconded by **Trustee Williams**. All ayes. Motion carried.
