## WATER REPORT

#### October 2024

Water report

All samples for the month have been collected and tested with satisfactory results.

Water main on Cooper, Grove, and Prospect has been installed and services are being tied in.

The tie in at the Prospect-Burgoyne intersection has become a problem. Material was removed from grade and the water main is not at the recommended five feet. A solution has still not been conceived.

We dug the curb boxes at 4 Summit and 4 Valley. We replaced the boxes and the keys for both residents.

232 Broadway is having water pressure issues. I went and took apart the meter and tested the flow through the meter horn. We concluded that the problem was sections of old galvanized pipe inside the house and not on our end.

The old hydrant near Cooper, on Burgoyne was abandoned and a new one was installed on Cooper.

I got a call at 9pm on the 11<sup>th</sup> for Burgoyne tank reading a level of 0. There is a feed that runs to the pressure switch that rotted away and started to flood the pit. I pumped it out and called Jeff for help. Jeff and I put a tapping saddle with a 3/4 " corp over the galvanized tap that rotted away. We shut it off after the leak was fixed. I gathered parts on the 12<sup>th</sup> and fixed the feed to the pressure censor.

The sewer department came over with the vac truck to help me clean the solids out of the PAC bulk tank. The transfer pump is cleaned out and in working order.

Air Compressor Engineering came on the 15<sup>th</sup> and replaced the motor in the newer compressor. It has been working fine since.

Fixed meter and turned water on at 97 East Street.

Called in on the 24<sup>th</sup> at 7:15pm for a power outage. I put 35 gallons of fuel in the generator. Power was restored at 3:10am on the 25<sup>th</sup>.

The flowmeter above the inlet of filter 3 stopped working. Tim came on the 29<sup>th</sup>, he replaced and programmed the new meter.

I am having some issues with the communication from the radio on the Burgoyne tower down to the pumphouse. Arvid believes it is either from moisture problems or the antenna on the tower has to be raised due to trees growing for the last 50 years and now interfering with the signal.

Finished the lead service line inventory and sent it out to the DOH.

All mark outs were completed in a timely manner.

All preventative maintenance and cleaning has been done for the month.
