LOCAL LAW No. 3 of 2010**

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF FORT EDWARD VEHICLE
AND TRAFFIC LAW**

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Authority.

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to Section 1640 of the NYS Vehicle and Traffic Law, the Code of the Village of Fort Edward, and the NYS Municipal Home Rule Law, and the NYS Village Law.

It is the intention of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fort Edward to amend the Local Law regulating vehicles and traffic in the Village. The Local Law amends the parking regulations by establishing time limits for parking in certain areas.

Section 2. Amendments to Language of Article VI Subsection 42

The Village hereby amends certain parking restrictions located in the Schedule of Time Limit Parking in Article VI, Subsection 42, Schedule XVI. No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit shown upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

BROADWAY	EAST	20 MINUTES 7:00AM – 5:00PM MON-FRI 7:00AM – 1:00PM SAT	BEGINNING AT VILLAGE HALL ENTRANCE RUNNING NORTH 155 FEET

Section 3. Repealer.

Any and all local laws or ordinances or parts of local laws or ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local Law are hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the

clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State

Section 3. Repealer.

Any and all local laws or ordinances or parts of local laws or ordinances in conflict with any part of this Local Law are hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 4. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective Date.

This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the New York State Secretary of State.


